Cancer cells as a weapon to fight against Cancer

Scientists at Stanford Medicine have successfully modified cancer cells to train the body's immune system to combat the specific cancer that the cells originated from. Ravi Majeti, who is a professor specializing in blood disorders and the main author of the study, said that this method could lead to a completely different way of treating cancer. The study was published on March 1st 2023 in a medical journal called Cancer Discovery. The main writer is Miles Linde, a person who used to study immunology and now works at the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Institute in Seattle. Some promising cancer treatments use the patient's immune system to fight the cancer. This can be done by either boosting the immune system or programming it to better recognize and attack the cancer. T cells are a part of the immune system that can be taught to recognize and fight against new viruses and cancers. They are trained to identify specific proteins in cancer cells that cause our immune system to respond. A better way is to program T cells to identify cancer by imitating how the body naturally reacts to diseases, similar to how a vaccine helps the immune system recognize harmful pathogens. In current study, scientists made changes to leukemia cells in mice to make some of them turn into APCs. When they tried out their cancer vaccine on mice, it successfully got rid of their cancer.

Exxua is an extended release capsule that selectively targets the serotonin 1A receptor.

Mechanism of Action

The mechanism of the antidepressant effect of Exxua is not fully understood but is believed to be related to its modulation of serotonin activity in the CNS through selective agonist activity at 5HT_{1a} receptors. Exxua and its active metabolite exhibit exclusive and strong binding affinity for 5HT_{1a} receptors.

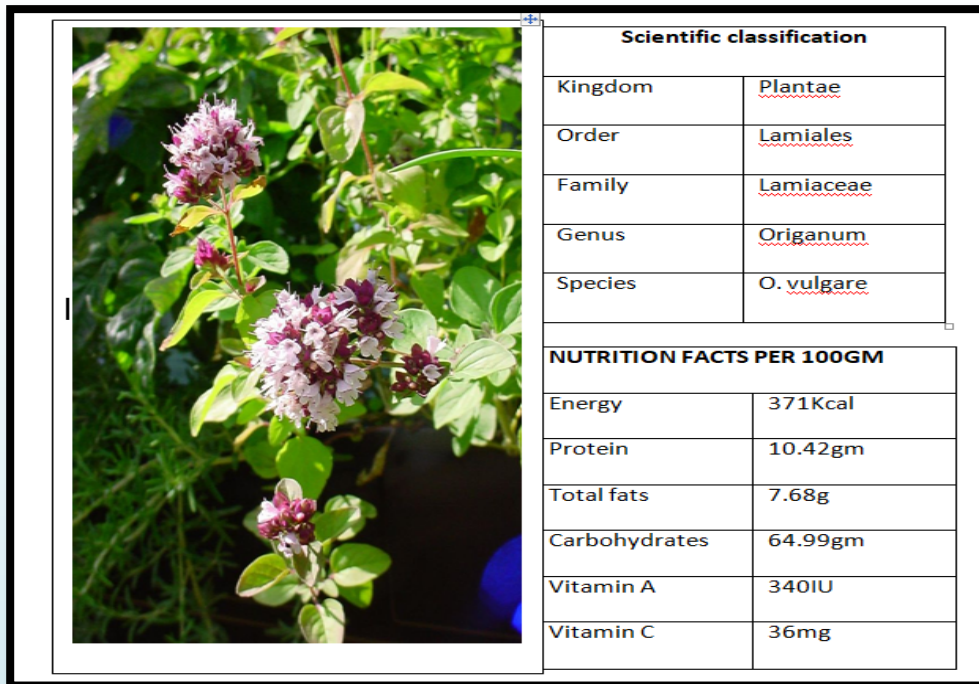

Plants with Health Benefits Oregano(*Origanum vulgare*)

Synonyms: marjoram, wild marjoram, winter sweet.

Oregano is a species of flowering plant in the mint family Lamiaceae.



Morphology: It has purple flowers and spade-shaped, olive-green leaves. It is a perennial, although it is grown as an annual in colder climates, as it often does not survive the winter. Oregano is planted in early spring, the plants being spaced 30 cm (12 in) apart in fairly dry soil, with full sun. It will grow in a pH range between 6.0 (mildly acidic) and 9.0 (strongly alkaline), with a preferred range between 6.0 and 8.0. It prefers a hot, relatively dry climate, but does well in other environments.

Chemical composition: the chemical compounds contributing to the flavour are carvacrol, thymol, limonene, pinene, ocimene, and caryophyllene.

Uses: oregano for centuries in herbal medicine to treat many ailments, including: skins sores, aching muscles, asthma, cramping, diarrhea, indigestion, colds to boost overall health.

Less Known Facts About Traditional Food

Beetroot Raita

Beetroot is of exceptional nutritional value; especially the greens, which are rich in calcium, iron and vitamins A and C. Beet roots, are an excellent source of folic acid and a very good source of fiber, manganese and potassium. Beet root raita is high in fiber, which helps to maintain blood sugar levels. Apart from this, Beetroot is high in potassium, which counteracts the negative effects of salt and also maintains healthy blood pressure levels. It helps control cholesterol, contains no fat and loaded with iron, copper and magnesium as well. It is a treasure of essential vitamins and antioxidants too. Since it is replete with Vitamin C, beetroot can be a valuable addition to your diet for good skin and immunity.

Recipe

To begin making the Beetroot Raita Recipe, first get all the ingredients ready and finely grate the beetroot and keep aside. In a large mixing bowl, add the yogurt, salt, cumin powder, green chillies and grated beetroot. Whisk well to combine. Check the salt and spice levels and adjust to suit your taste. Transfer the raita to a serving bowl. The final step is the make the seasoning. Heat oil in a tadka pan; add the mustard seeds, urad dal and allow it to crackle and the dal to turn golden brown and crisp. Finally stir in the curry leaves and turn off the heat. Pour the seasoning onto the Beetroot Raita and serve.
